# ASH PRESENTATION SEMINAR

## Directions:

Take the Monarto exit off the South Eastern Freeway. Turn right if you are coming from Adelaide and left if you are coming from Murray Bridge (ie travel South). You will go over the freeway bridge and onto a gravel Rd (Ferries McDonald Rd). Travel approx 10kms. Chalani Australian Stock Horses is on the right.

Look for the Green and Gold sign at the driveway.

The southern most end of Ferries McDonald Rd is also accessible via Chauncey's Line Rd (opposite Red Creek Rd) off the Strathalbyn—Callington Rd at Hartley, or via Kangaroo Rd off Wellington Rd (when coming from Langhorne Creek or Wellington).
