| ❖ * Youth events – either Youth Handler or Youth Judging to run on the day, not both. | ❖ Novice ASH – A horse remains a novice until it has won three novices or an open class at any show, open gymkhana or similar event, except wins in youth or restricted age class. Maiden horses may compete in novice classes |
| ❖ All youth competing for Youth High Points or Youth ASHS Trophies must be a financial member or immediate family of a financial Member. | ❖ WHIPS no restriction on whips in led classes. Dressage Whips & hacking canes not permitted in working classes. |
| ❖ Youth may compete as a Youth Competitor until the end of the ASHS SA Central Branch Show Season in which they turn 18. | ❖ All horses competing must be owned/leased by a financial Member of the Australian Stock horse Society Ltd. Persons under 18 yrs are not permitted to handle or ride Stallions or Colts. |
| ❖ Youth competing for High Points or trophies can only do so on a registered Stock Horse. | ❖ DRESS: as per ASH Society Ltd Events Handbook |
| ❖ Under 13 yrs, Youth Members or immediate family of a Member, can compete on an unregistered mount in youth classes. | |

2. Best Presented Australian Stock Horse & Handler (English or traditional)
3. Led Colt or Gelding 3 yrs & under
4. Led Filly 3yrs & under

CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION JUNIOR ASH (from class 3 & 4)

5. Led ASH Stallion 4yrs & over
6. Led ASH Mare 4 yrs & over
7. Led Gelding 4 yrs & over

CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION SENIOR ASH (from class 5, 6 & 7)

8. * ASH Hack, Youth Rider
9. ASH Hack 4 yrs & under
10. Novice ASH Hack (Maidens may compete – see Rules & Regulations)
11. Ridden ASH Hack
12. Open Educated Hack

CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION ASH HACK (from class 9, 10, 11 & 12)

13. * Working ASH, Youth Rider
14. * Station / Utility Mount, Youth Rider
15. ASHLA (Australian Stock Horse Ladies' Association - open to all ASHLA members, proof of membership to be carried and produced upon request, ribbons awarded 1st - 3rd Riders over 18 years, and ribbons awarded 1st - 3rd Riders 13 - 18 years)
16. ASH Working, 4 yrs & under
17. Novice Working ASH (No stockwhip required) (Maidens may compete – see Rules & Regulations)
18. Open Working ASH (Traditional Dress, pattern supplied, Stockwhip required)
19. Station/Utility ASH

CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION WORKING ASH (from class 16, 17, 18 & 19)

When required by a hosting show committee a Supreme Led or Ridden will be awarded
