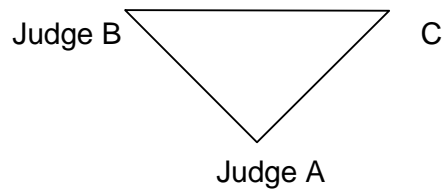

Led Workout – All classes



1. Entire class to walk clockwise around arena for inspection and to return to marshalling area when directed by steward.
2. Each horse to present to Judge A for inspection.
Walk to Judge B and stop for inspection.
Walk remainder of triangle via C.
3. Trot triangle A, B, C, A and halt past A before leaving arena.
